# Signing up for Remind



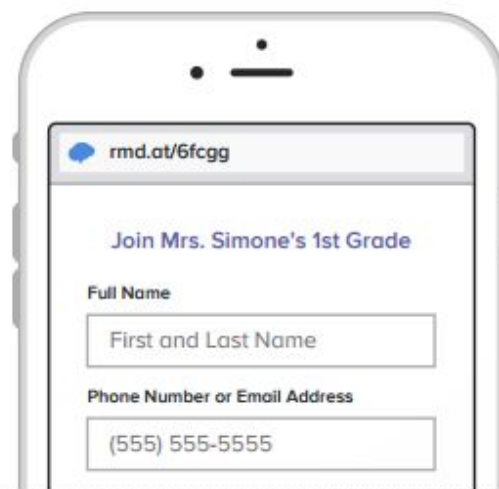
Pick a way to receive messages for **Mrs. Simone's 1st Grade**:

**A** If you have a smartphone, get push notifications.

On your iPhone or Android phone, open your web browser and go to the following link:

Follow the instructions to sign up for Remind. You'll be prompted to download the mobile app.



**B** If you don't have a smartphone, get text notifications.

Text the message [@6fcgg](https://t.me/6fcgg) to the number 81010.
